- Fall Festival (Amanda): Inventory of viable games; Organized the storage unit; Created a wish list to purchase for Fall Festival and other events sustainable for many years; Propose we purchase wire shelving to better organize and protect items in our storage unit; Lori sent an email mid-July about Fall Festival games; JENGA is a duplicate/improvement, but we do have one (albeit warn out); Organizing the storage unit by event type (i.e. labeling, wire shelf sections, etc.); Check insurance policy with inflatable soccer (Shiva); Decided in July meeting to create a wish list to vote on a budget in August meeting
- Terri made a move to approve a one-time \$3,000 Capital Expenditure for new fall festival games and storage wire shelving; Jaime Seconded the motion; Members voted and the motion passed.
