

## SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION 2024-2025

The Cochran's Crossing Village Association (CCVA) awards scholarships to outstanding local high school students planning to pursue higher education. These five ONE-TIME \$1,000. scholarships recognize and encourage a spirit of community involvement and good citizenship among students residing in the Village of Cochran's Crossing in The Woodlands, Texas.

Scholarships are open to high school seniors who are residents of Cochran's Crossing at the time of application, regardless of school attended. Proof of residency in CCVA will be established with a copy of your or a parent's driver's license. Applicants must be in good standing at their current school at the time of application AND plan to attend either a 2- or 4-year college, or an accredited vocational or trade school beginning in the Summer or Fall of 2024.

SELECTION CRITERIA: Scholarships will be awarded based on your application with emphasis on the following criteria (listed in no particular order):

- Academic performance
- Citizenship & community involvement
- Extracurricular activities
- Financial need

Recipients will be awarded a one thousand-dollar (\$1,000.00) scholarship (total number of awards given varies from year to year). Applications will be reviewed by the CCVA Board Scholarship Committee. **Only complete applications will be considered.** Actual scholarship award money will be credited directly to the student's account at the college or university once accepted and enrolled.

- **Résumé**. In your résumé, please include:
  - List of extracurricular activities
  - o List of activities participated within the community
  - How long you have lived in Cochran's Crossing
  - Scholarships and Financial Aid Applied for/received
- Recommendation letter from teacher, coach, or sponsor
- Most recent unofficial transcript
- Copy of driver's license for proof of residency
- **ONE-page typed statement** showing how YOU demonstrate community involvement and citizenship. (*Only one page please*)

All application information will be kept strictly confidential, except that the CCVA reserves the right to publish the names, high school, intended college & major, and a photograph of all scholarship award winners and alternates in its publications or promotional material.
